Alaska Joint Agency Vessel of Concern Reporting Form

This form was developed in 2014 by an ad-hoc multi-agency ADV Task Force.

The purpose of the VOC Reporting Form is to track vessels that are, or may become, hazards to the environment or navigation in Alaskan waters.

Alaska does not currently have an ADV Program. These forms are compiled by the AK Dept. of

Natural Resources (ADNR) and distributed to a list of agencies that respond to ADV concerns.

ADNR is developing an online database for ADV in Alaska. These forms will be used to populate that database, and provide a broad picture of the scope of ADV around the state.
